SEEKING CAMP STAFF Vermont Works for Women is seeking energetic and committed leaders to staff our Summer Programs in Essex Junction and Barre, Vermont.

Rosie's Girls[®] is a three-week trades exploration day camp for middle school girls that includes strong arts, self-expression, and team-building components. The staff operates in a collaborative team environment to support and supervise 24 girls individually and collectively in various trades and arts instruction.

Duties include: facilitating games & discussions; leading group activities; forming positive connections with participants; helping to provide physical and emotional safety; brainstorming innovative ideas with other staff; and having a good time at this really cool camp. Creativity, flexibility, self-direction, and the ability to relate positively and respectfully to pre-adolescent girls, and a commitment to equity in education and the workforce are required. Trades experience is helpful but not necessary.
